GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 1. Regional Swimming Championships shall be competed for annually and subject to any standard the Regional Swimming Committee (RSC) may impose. The Championships shall be open to any member of a club affiliated to the ASA East Region who is eligible within the meaning of ASA Law.
- 2. Any swimmer failing to comply with any of the conditions shall not be allowed to compete in the championship.
- 3. Protests shall be made and dealt with as detailed in ASA Law and Regulations. The Promoter, Tom Baster, Swimming Manager, ASA East Region, can be contacted at <u>swimming@eastswimming.org</u> If the ASA East Region Swimming Manager is not present, or is required to fulfil another duty, a Meet Director will be appointed. In such circumstances, the Meet Director will act as Promoter.
- 4. All participants must observe the safety precautions in operation at the venue.
- 5. The ASA East Region will not be responsible for any loss or damage occurring during this meet.

6. Entries

- 6.1 A swimmer entered in the name of one club in the individual events may not compete in the name of another club in the team events. A swimmer must be a member of the club in whose name he/she is entered and must have been registered as such, with the ASA, prior to the entry closing date of the competition.
- 6.2 No swimmer competing in a like championship of any other region in the same year is eligible to compete in these championships.
- 6.3 Entry times for all individual events must be taken from the British Swimming rankings on or before the closing date and shall have been achieved in meets, licensed at Level 1, 2 or 3 by the ASA, SASA or WASA, from 1 September 2017. The closing date will be four weeks before the competition. For Weekend 1, which includes the Para-Swimming events, this is midday on Friday 6 April 2018 and for Weekend 2 this is midday on Friday 27 April 2018. For the 800m (Male) and 1500m (Female) Event this is midday on Friday 21 April. Subsequent improved times will not be accepted.
- 6.4 Only entries made electronically will be considered. All entries from a club shall be consolidated by a club official and made using the SPORTSYSTEMS Entry Manager Rev 2.0 software which may be freely downloaded at <u>www.sportsys.co.uk</u>
- 6.5 Submission of an electronic entry file will be regarded as full acceptance and agreement to all conditions within this entry pack.
- 6.6 The SPORTSYSTEMS Entry Manager Rev 2.0 export file containing submitted entries and full payment shall reach the Entry Administrator not later than the advertised closing date. Late entries will be rejected.
- 6.7 Acknowledgement and acceptance of a correctly submitted entry shall be by publishing a received entries listing on the Championship page at <u>www.eastswimming.org</u> Clubs will have 7 days from the date that entries are posted on the website to check the received entries report and errors after which a final accepted entries list will be published and no further corrections allowed. We will check that payments were received by the closing date and reserve the right to reject entries where this was not the case.
- 6.8 Dependent on the number of entries, the Promoter reserves the right to reject entries to achieve what is believed to be the best compromise between the events. If necessary to reject entries the slowest entries will be rejected first.
- 6.9 Entries to this meet will be held on a computer and consent, as required by the Data Protection Act 1998, to the holding of personal information on computer will be deemed to have been given by the submission of the entry. Personal data will be available for inspection during the Meet on application to the Promoter.

7. Fees

- 7.1 Entry fees are £7 per event and £10 per event for Team races.
- 7.2 Spectator fees are £5 for one heat session or £10 for both heat sessions per day. There are no reductions for concessions. There is no charge for the finals sessions.
- 7.3 ASA East Region will restrict access to the spectator seating to comply with safety limits.

8. Access to Poolside

- 8.1 No coach or swimmer may access poolside more than 30 minutes before the commencement of the first warm up session on each day.
- 8.2 Access to poolside is restricted to competitors for the session, coaches with coach passes, technical officials and appointed volunteers.
- 8.3 No additional equipment such as chairs or treatment tables may be brought onto poolside.

9. Warm Up

- 9.1 For heat sessions, Warm Up will commence one hour before the session start time, with the exception of sessions involving 800/1500m events. For final sessions, Warm Up will commence 35 minutes before the session start time.
- 9.2 A warm up procedure will be published on the ASA East Region website one week before the event.

10. Age Groups

- 10.1 The age groups for both genders in each event will be 11/12, 13, 14, 15, 16 and 17 and over.
- 10.2 Team events will be 14 to 16 years and 17 years and over.

11. Events

- 11.1 All events shall have individual age group finals except the 400m, 800m and 1500m Freestyle and the 400m I.M. which shall be timed finals. Each final shall have a maximum of two reserves declared.
- 11.2 Team declaration forms must be submitted to the recorder no later than the start of the relevant session's warm up (i.e. for heats sessions one hour before the start of the session and for finals session 40 minutes before the start of the session).

12. Withdrawals

- 12.1 Heats and Team Events Once an entry is accepted a competitor shall swim or give notice of withdrawal. Notice of any withdrawals shall be reported by a representative of the club to the recorder using the appropriate withdrawal form. For individual and team events this must be before the commencement of the session warm up. For the 50m Breaststroke events on weekend two, withdrawals must be made prior to the commencement of the additional warm-up for that session. Clubs may make withdrawals via email to the Entries Manager at <u>entriesmanager@eastswimming.org</u> providing this is before 4 pm on the Friday prior the championships
- 12.1 **Finals -** The names of finalists and reserves will be announced and published. Withdrawals must be made to the recorder within 15 minutes of the announcement. At the end of this period reserves may ask the recorder whether they are required for the final or can be stood down.
- 12.1 Unless notice of withdrawal has been given to the recorders within 15 minutes of the publication of the heat results, all finalists shall report to the Clerk of the Course for the final. Withdrawals after the 15 minute deadline may only be made on medical grounds.
- 12.1 **All events -** where a withdrawal is made after the deadlines on medical grounds the swimmer may not compete for the rest of that day.
- 12.5 Any swimmer not present when required to swim shall incur a £10 penalty, unless the recorder had been notified, prior to the race, of medical grounds that prevented the swimmer taking part. After the championships the Club, in whose name the competitor has entered the competition, will be invoiced for the fine and will have 28 days in which to make the payment. Swimmers not present will be identified from the results where "DNC" is recorded for them. If the payment is not made within the 28 days the fine will be increased to £50 per DNC and no entries will be accepted from the club for swimming events until the fine is paid.

13. Awards

- 13.1 The first three swimmers in each age group for all events shall each receive medals.
- 13.2 In the 11/12, 13 and 14 years age groups, top boy and top girl awards will be presented to the swimmer with the most points across individual events. Points will be calculated on the basis of 3 points for a gold medal, 2 for a silver and 1 for a bronze.
- 13.3 The Don Neate Memorial Trophy will be open to swimmers in the 14 years and younger age groups and will be awarded to the swimmer with the most points across individual events. Points will be calculated on the basis of 3 points for a gold medal, 2 for a silver and 1 for a bronze.
- 13.4 The Warwick Thompson Memorial Trophy for Top Club at the East Swimming Long Course Championships will be awarded to the club that finishes top of the combined medals table for Weekends 1 and 2, incorporating Para-Swimming events and including the 800m (Male) and 1500m (Female) Event. Clubs are ranked according to the number of gold medals won at the championships. In the event of a tie for the number of gold medals won, the tied club with the highest number of silver medals shall be declared the winner. In the event of a tie for gold and silver medals, the trophy shall be awarded to the tied club with highest number of bronze medals. In event that two or more clubs tie for the number of gold, silver and bronze medals, the award shall be shared.

14. Photography and Safeguarding

- 14.1 No photography is permitted in the changing rooms. Any person found to be contravening this condition will be required to leave the competition and venue without refund.
- 14.2 All persons attending these championships should exercise reasonable caution when using cameras and other such image-capturing devices, particularly with regard to sharing images on social media.
- 14.3 Any safeguarding and child protection concerns should be reported to the Promoter. If the concerns relate to the conduct of the Promoter, the report must be made to a member of the ASA East Region Management Committee

Dry Land Training Area

- **15** Subject to availability, the RSC may provide a dry land training area. If such a facility is provided, use of the facility will be in accordance with supplementary safety conditions, published in advance of the competition.
- 16. Any question arising, for which these conditions do not provide, shall be determined by the Promoter.
- **17.** Any information included in the entry pack (including information published separately on the East Swimming website) shall be regarding as part of the General Conditions.

800m (Male) and 1500m (Female) Session

- **18.** All age groups will compete on Saturday 19th May at Basildon Sporting Village. Age groups will be as per 10.1.
- **19.** Female athletes are eligible to compete in the 1500m Freestyle if they have achieved the 800m Freestyle qualifying time for their age group. Male athletes are eligible to compete in the 800m Freestyle if they have achieved the 400m Freestyle or 1500m Freestyle qualifying time for their age group. Qualifying times must have been achieved by the entry closing date and at the level of meet set out in condition 6.3.
- **20.** The Women's 1500m Freestyle will be seeded by 800m Freestyle times. The Men's 800m Freestyle will be seeded by 400m Freestyle times. The Sportsystems entry file will be configured so that only the swimmer's best performance in these events within the regional qualification window can be used to enter.
- For the Men's 800m Freestyle, if a swimmer has a Regional 400m qualifying time, they must enter with this time. Clubs administrators entering swimmers with only a 1500m qualifying time should do so by emailing <u>entriesmanager@eastswimming.org</u>. Swimmers entering with only a 1500m time will be seeded by their best 400m Freestyle time, taken from rankings.

Entry Procedure

This procedure is for entries only. **Please do not** send any coach pass applications to the entry adminstrator.

All entries from a club shall be consolidated and submitted electronically to the Entry Manager. **ONE** electronic payment or cheque shall be made as a consolidated payment of all the entries.Download and install the SPORTSYSTEMS Entry Manager V2.0 from <u>www.sportsys.co.uk</u>. If you have previously installed this program ensure you check and download the latest version by using the 'Check for Updates' option. Download and save the Entry File Set from the Championships Entry page at <u>www.eastswimming.org.uk</u>

Full instructions can be found within the program under Help and a quick start video is also available on the SPORTSYSTEM website.

The only way to enter individual times is by using the 'Get Times' button ensuring the entered time satisfies the entry conditions. No other method of providing times will be accepted, except as per Condition 21*. Times retrieved from British Swimming (BS) rankings that do not satisfy the qualification time will be flagged with a yellow 'N' swim button. Times which satisy the qualification time are shown with a green 'Y' swim button. Click any unrequired green 'Y' swim buttons.

*Entering the 800m (Male) and 1500m (Female) Event:

The 800m Freestyle for men and 1500m Freestyle for women are new regional events for 2018. Female swimmers are eligible to enter the 1500m Freestyle if they have the regional 800m Freestyle qualifying time for their age group. Male swimmers are eligible to enter the 800m Freestyle if they have the regional 400m Freestyle or 1500m Freestyle qualifying times for their age group.

The Sportsystems entry file will be configured to enable club administrators to enter swimmers via the 'Get Times' button. Swimmers with a 400m regional qualifying time (Male) or an 800m regional qualifying time (Female) <u>must</u> be entered using these times, via the 'Get Times' button on Sportsystems.

Only when a male swimmer has a 1500m qualifying time, but no 400m qualifying time, should entries be made by the club administrator sending an email with the title '800m Men' to the Entries Manager at entriesmanager@eastswimming.org. In such cases, the swimmer will have their fastest 400m time taken from rankings and this will be used as their entry time.

Clubs entering Para-Swimmers should identify the correct S, SB & SM sport class in the drop-down boxes and leave the Disability Exception Code box blank. For an event to be entered, the swim button must be green 'Y'. Any events flagged yellow 'N' from times retrieved from BS rankings will require the swim button clicked until it changes to green 'Y' and the entry time shows 'YES' The Entry Adminstrator will convert these 'YES' entry times to the times in BS Rankings, detail the times you believe meet the requirements in the e mail submitting the entry. Note: if, after saving a swimmers entry, the entry is reopened for editing, you must ensure any events entered have the swim button set to 'Y' again before saving.

Entry times for all individual events must only be taken from the British Swimming rankings on or before the closing date and shall have been achieved in meets, licensed at Level 1, 2 or 3 by the ASA, SASA or WASA, from 1 September 2017. The closing date will be four weeks before the competition. For Weekend 1 this is midday on Friday 6 April 2018 and for Weekend 2 this is midday on Friday 27 April 2018. For the 800m (Male) and 1500m (Female) Session this is midday on Friday 21 April 2018. Subsequent improved times will not be accepted. The best short course time will be populated which includes conversion of long course times V1281015

Information about Coaches' Pool Deck Pass and Food

- All coaches planning to be on poolside at the Regional Championships must apply for a Coaches' Deck Pass for each weekend of the Championships. There are no annual coach passes.
- It is the responsibility of the club to ensure that the coaches named have been DBS checked.
- Passes will be issued in the name of your club and shall be collected from the Officials Room on the day of competition, before going poolside. Passes will not be mailed out
- Clubs with twenty or less swimmers may apply for a maximum of two passes. Where there are more than twenty swimmers, a club may apply for additional passes to maintain a 1:10 ratio
- Passes are £15 each for a whole weekend or part thereof. For the 800m (Male) and 1500m (Female) Session passes will be £5 each.
- Passes may only be used by the coaches/helpers named on this form. All named persons must be ASA members
- All swimmers aged 16 years and under must be under the supervision of a pass holder during the warm up, competition and in the vicinity of the pool
- Passes may only be used when there are swimmers from your club on the deck
- Passes must be worn in a prominent place whilst on the pool deck. Coaches without passes on display will be asked to leave and may be refused readmission
- Coach passes will entitle the holder to tea and coffee provided in the Officials Room
- There is an additional charge for food, the price of which reflects the price charged by the operator at each venue. Food between sessions can be provided only if booked in advance on this form
- Please complete the attached forms to order coach passes and food. There are separate forms for Weekend 1 and Weekend 2 to reflect the competition closing dates.

WITHDRAWAL NOTIFICATION

12. Withdrawals

12.1 Heats and Team Events - Once an entry is accepted a competitor shall swim or give notice of withdrawal. Notice of any withdrawals shall be reported by a representative of the club to the recorder using the appropriate withdrawal form. For heats this must be one hour before the start of the event. For team events this must be before the commencement of the session warm up. Clubs may make withdrawals via email to the Entries Manager at <u>entriesmanager@eastswimming.org</u> providing this is before 4 pm on the Friday prior the championships

12.2 Finals - The names of finalists and reserves will be announced and published. Withdrawals must be made to the recorder within 15 minutes of the announcement. At the end of this period reserves may ask the recorder whether they are required for the final or can be stood down.

12.3 Unless notice of withdrawal has been given to the recorders within 15 minutes of the publication of the heat results, all finalists shall report to the Clerk of the Course for the final. Withdrawals after the 15 minute deadline may only be made on medical grounds.

12.4 All events - where a withdrawal is made after the deadlines on medical grounds the swimmer may not compete for the rest of that day.

12.5 Any swimmer not present when required to swim shall incur a £10 penalty, unless the recorder had been notified, prior to the race, of medical grounds that prevented the swimmer taking part. After the championships the Club, in whose name the competitor has entered the competition, will be invoiced for the fine and will have 28 days in which to make the payment. Swimmers not present will be identified from the results where "DNC" is recorded for them. If the payment is not made within the 28 days the fine will be increased to £50 per DNC and no entries will be accepted from the club for swimming events until the fine is paid."
