Conditions

1. The closing date for entry is Friday 13th March 2020
2. The gala will take place at Diss Leisure Centre, Victoria Road, Diss IP22 4JG which is a 25m pool with anti-wave devices in place
3. The entry fee is £3.00 for each event
4. Competitors age as of 21st March 2020
Swimmers must be SLOWER than the cut off times to be eligible.
5. Clubs must submit entries using Sportsystems Entry Manager, submitting all entries by email to events@dissottters.co.uk no later than the deadline. Payment to be by BACS to the Club Account or club cheque (1 per club).
6. Entries must have been completed correctly, submitted by the specified date and accepted by the promoters for an entry to be valid. The promoters reserve the right to restrict the number of entries if necessary; this will be done by rejecting the faster swimmers first.
7. A list of provisional entries will be published on the Diss Otters Swimming Club's website after the close date. Clubs will then need to check these and notify the organisers of any errors.
8. It is the responsibility of the club to advise the gala organisers if they have swimmers not swimming either by email prior to the meet or by completing a withdrawal form on the night. Forms must be returned to the timing desk no later than 15 minutes before the start of the first race. Forms to do so will be provided. This will prevent the gala running with empty lanes. No refund will be given for any withdrawals. Any deviations from this condition may only be at the discretion of the Lead referee and/or promoter.
9. The time allocated for the warm up at the start of each gala may be extended to prevent overcrowding in the pool. This will lead to the advertised start time being changed.
10. All heats will be seeded according to the submitted entry times (not by age).
11. Results will be declared by the following age groups: 8yrs, 9yrs, 10yrs, 11/OV. All results will be Heat Declared Winners.
12. Awards will be distributed to the top 3 competitors in each age group.
13. The promoters reserve the right to refuse admission to any competitor, coach or spectator. Anything not covered in the above rules will be at the discretion of the promoters and/or lead referees, who also reserve the right to make any changes that may be considered necessary for the smooth, effective and safe running of the meet.
14. Entries to this meet will be held on a computer and consent, as required by the General Data Protection Act 2018, to the use of personal information will be deemed to have been given by the submission of the entry. The Data Protection Act 2018 requires us to provide you with certain information and to obtain your consent before processing data about you. Processing includes: obtaining, recording, holding, disclosing, destruction or retaining information. We require certain personal data for the purposes of making entries to the competition, managing the meet and the submission of results to Rankings. The information provided by you will be processed in accordance with the Data Protection Act 2018. Where the personal data of competitors, officials and coaches/team managers has been passed to us by a third party such as a club rather than by the individuals themselves, we rely on the third party to ensure that consent has been obtained. 15. In accordance with the SE Child Safeguarding Policies and Procedures, any parents or carers of swimmers under the age of 18 who wish to take photographic or video images are requested to focus on their own child as much as reasonably possible and to avoid including other children in those images. Should you have any concerns about photography or filming please bring them to the attention of the Promoter.
16. Any matter not covered by these conditions will be determined by the Promoter and/or Referee, subject to Swim England Laws, Regulations and the Swim England Technical Rules of Racing
